My dear Professor Gregorius,

I was very glad to get
your post-card by this

you the Ibn Hazm along
with this letter.

Since I came to India
I have made many
'traverses' in the realm
of Shi'a literature, and
I am devoting what
little space time I have
to putting my materials

in order.

I am sending you a brief report on my first organised search for Arabic & Persian MSS. You will see from this that there are in Lucknow several libraries which are quite unknown to the outer world, and which are especially rich in Shī'a literature. In these libraries I found the works of several other Qummi's besides Ibn Babawayh.

(1) محسن بن محمد بن حسن القمي (2.378)

(2) ابو الحسن علي بن ابراهيم بن هاشم القمي (circa 400)

(3) محمد بن الحسن الصفار ابو جعفر القمي (2.295)

Moreover I found several works by Ibn Babawayh al-Qummi which are apparently unknown in Europe.

Maulavi Nagi Hossain's library also contains a very valuable Shi'a Bibliography called الكتاب by one نجيب الدين, of which I have ordered a copy to be made. In this Fikrīyah is mentioned another Ibn Babawayh.
