I beg to acknowledge receipt of your postal card of April 15, and greatly regret that I did not know earlier that you desired reprints of your article which is appearing in the published proceedings of the Congress of Arts and Science. It has not been our custom to make these reprints except upon special request, and probably not more than 20 out of the 300 speakers have thus requested them. I should have been very glad indeed, however, to have ordered them for you had I known of your desire.
