on to you. I shall be only too pleased to get you any further
books you require. If you will send me a list of such books
I shall endeavour to get them as soon as possible.

I have seen in the American reactionary journal "Commentary"
a side reference to you and as expected very hostile. You

book by Louis Harrap on the "Social roots of the Arts". He

American journal on the Propaganda and Partisanship, published
in the Partisan Review in New York, 1934. He quotes profusely
what you have to say. You probably also know that the

your book "Geschichte und Klassen-Bewusstsein".
