In connection with your kind offer to publish some of my works /your proposition was to publish the study on the young Marx/ I answer, of course, in the affirmative. I seize the opportunity to remind you of your previous interest for Agnes Heller's book, The Renaissance Man. As far as I am informed, there is a certain delay in the negotia-

tions. I hope this would not mean a refusal on your part?
