Dear M. Lukacs,

The National United Committee, as is true of any emergency-spawned organization, is presently experiencing some growing pains. However, in spite of the difficulties, great progress is being made relative to building the movement we feel will be necessary to win the freedom of Angela Davis.

A subcommittee on publications has been charged with developing educational material to bring, to broad masses, understanding of the political factors involved in the necessary struggle to free Angela Davis. These materials, as they become available, will be distributed to organizations and concerned individuals with prices suggested for their bulk orders.

One project of the subcommittee, for example, is the reproduction of Angela's first two lectures at U.C.L.A. with a letter to her from Prof. Herbert Marcuse - under whom Angela studied both at Brandeis University and at the University of California at San Diego - as an introduction. Another such project is the collection of statements in her behalf, by a wide variety of public figures, to be used in another form. The gathering of poetry to, of and by her has been taken on by a special projects group for reproduction. A brief biography, focusing on her political development and stressing her fight to end the injustice inherent in the courts and the inhuman practices in the prison system, is in production.

All of the foregoing, together with updated material as the case develops - and visual tools such as posters, buttons, birthday cards and bumper tapes, will comprise a ANGELA DAVIS FREEDOM KIT to be sent to concerned groups around the nation and the world to both raise the funds necessary to conduct her defense AND to help those who wish to bring the story of Angela to the broad forces necessary to create an atmosphere in which she may receive something approaching justice:
