Re: ZUR DEBATTE ZWISCHEN CHINA UND DER SOWJECTUNION
-- THEORETISCHE-PHILOSOPHISCHE BEMERKUNGEN --

I would like to take the liberty of writing to you concerning the reprinting of the above thesis in the Japanese language.

We IWANAMI SHOTEN, a publisher of the Japanese versions of your "Balzac und der Franzosische Realismus", "Breve Histoire de la Litterature Allemande" and "Existentialisme ou Marxisme", publish "SHISO", a semi-academic monthly journal covering philosophy and social sciences which having a circulation of more than 15,000 copies every issue, enjoys great influence on the Japanese intellectuals.
