Memorandum of Agreement made this 3rd day of Feb.
 of the year 1904 between Prof. L. Goldziher (herein-
 after to be called the Author) and the FUNK & WERNALLS COMPANY, of
 30 Lafayette Place, New York (hereinafter to be called the Publisher).

Author and Publisher

I.
Articles to be supplied
within specified time

The Author hereby undertakes to write for publication in "THE JEWISH ENCYCLOPEDIA" the articles specified in the accompanying schedule (A), and agrees to deliver the same within the time herein explicitly stated, time being of the essence of the contract.

II.
Mode of Payment

The Publisher hereby agrees to pay the Author for his manuscript at the rate of Five (\$5) Dollars for one thousand words for matter written in English, and Three and one-half (\$3.50) Dollars for one thousand words for matter in French, German, Italian, or Hebrew. Payment for said manuscript to be made as follows: One-half on receipt of the manuscript approved by the Department Editor [when the quantity forwarded has reached not less than two thousand (2,000) words]; the remaining half within six weeks after publication.

III.
Editorial Revision

The Author hereby agrees to follow the general instructions laid down for his guidance, and the Publisher agrees to arrange for the editing of the articles for insertion in the ENCYCLOPEDIA.

IV.
Use of Copyright
Matter

The Author hereby agrees not to use any printed matter that has been protected by copyright, without (1) obtaining permission to use the same; (2) citing the source from which such matter is derived; and (3) notifying the Publisher of the fact.

V.
Right of Contraction of
Articles

It is hereby agreed that articles extending beyond the scheduled number of words may be cut down; and in any event the Publisher is obligated to pay only for the number stipulated in the schedule.

VI.
Copyright to vest in
Publishers

In consideration of the execution of provision II. of this agreement, the Author hereby surrenders all copyright in any article written by him for the said JEWISH ENCYCLOPEDIA, to the FUNK & WAGNALLS COMPANY, and undertakes not to print and publish elsewhere any article or part of any article written for this ENCYCLOPEDIA.

VII.
Past and Future
Articles

It is hereby agreed that the various provisions herein set forth also apply to such other articles for the JEWISH ENCYCLOPEDIA as may have been already, or shall be in the future, assigned to the Author to write.

VIII.
This Agreement to bind
Heirs, Executors, and
Assigns

The term Author and Publisher shall apply equally to the heirs, executors, and assigns of the persons herein mentioned.
