My dear Professor Goldziher:-

I am very much obliged to you for your card of the 2d inst. I did not know of the pamphlet directed against Mohammed Abdu which you mention, and I shall try to procure it from Egypt. It was almost impossible to get information in regard to such things in Cairo. I am also quite in the dark regarding his activity in Beirut at the time of his exile, though I am trying to get the information from a certain F. Antone, the editor of an Arabic paper in New York called -"al-Jamyat", who seems to have known him.

I did not know that the sentence I used on page 194, was a hadith of the prophet. Could you tell me where I could find it? I have tried in the Kanz al-Ummal; but I find that work as difficult to use as many other Mohammedan works of a similar character.

What you write about the Jewish Behaist is amusing. It can be paralleled here by a number of Jews who have become ardent Christian Scientists.
