My dear Sir:-

On page 16 in Bulletin No.6 of THE XVI INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF ORIENTALISTS, recently held at Athens, you will find mention of (3me Séance plénière) the Gift, which I had the honour to present to the Royal Greek Government, viz: a full-size reproduction in-plaster of the Chinese Nestorian Monument of A.D.781 (valued at several thousand francs).

In 1907-08 I was the Leader of the HOLM-NESTORIAN EXPEDITION TO SIAN-FU, about which you have possibly heard or read. I have sent to the Royal Hungarian Academy some literature on this subject.

Prof. Dr. Léczy de Léczy, the Chief of the Geological Institute, who visited Sian-fu with Count Szechenyi many years ago, is in possession of all the facts relating to an offer to the Hungarian Government, which I have made. Under certain circumstances I shall be glad to present to Hungary a Nestorian Reproduction, similar to the one I have given to Greece. Will you be kind enough to call on Prof. Léczy at your convenience in order to obtain the facts of the case, which may, perhaps, be a little out of his department.
