Dear Professor Goldziher

As you are probably aware, Messrs. Israel Abrahams and Claude G. Montefiore, who edited the Jewish Quarterly Review for a period of 20 years, decided, some time since, to discontinue its publication. Feeling that the absence of this medium for the publication of research would be a serious loss to Jewish learning, the Dropsie College will make itself responsible for continuing the Quarterly. The undersigned and Doctor Solomon Schechter, President of the Jewish Theological Seminary of America and a Governor of this College, will act as the Editors of the Review with the assistance of eminent scholars. It is hoped that the scholars who contributed to the Review in the past will continue to publish here from time to time, and your contributions, as Philosopher, Historian and Philologist, are cordially solicited. The new series of the Review will be edited on practically the same lines as heretofore, except that for the present, at least, every number will be limited to 150 pages. Contributors are requested to keep their articles within the limit of twenty pages. Articles longer than thirty pages will usually be published in installments, the object being to render it possible that, at least, five or six authors shall have the opportunity of publication in each number.
