Dear Professor Goldziher:

One of the Arabic manuscripts of the Landberg Collection, now in New Haven, ~~is~~ contains a brief treatise entitled كتاب مسالك النظر في نبوة سيد البشر, which was written near the beginning of the 14th century (This ms. dated 720 A.H.) by a ^{converted} Jew named *سليمان بن جهم*, to prove that Moham- med was the prophet foretold in the Hebrew Scriptures. Landberg adds, in his manuscript catalogue, "Goldziher hat die Wichtigkeit und Eigenthümlichkeit dieses Werkes

in Z. D. M. G. — hervor-
gehoben." I have looked through
the files of the Z. D. M. G., but with-
out success. If you have pub-
lished anything in regard to this
manuscript, or concerning such
treatises as this one, I shall be
very much obliged to you if you
will give me the reference, so
that I may look at the article.
One of my pupils is intending to
publish the Arabic text with a
translation.
