The Hungarian Copyright-Office kindly informed us that copyrights on your works are under your own control

Accordingly we have the pleasure to inform you as follows

NOLIT, one of the biggest Yugoslav Publishing Houses has the intention to present to their readers a SERBO-CROATE translation of your ESSAYS.

Serbe and Croate are two dialects of one and the same language.

We wish to stress your attention to the fact that we pay royalties in dinars which are deposited with our National Bank on a blocked account opened in the name of the Author or any other person duly authorised by the same. The agreed advance as well as all other amounts in connection with copy rights can be spent in our country for not commercial purposes. We pay 5% of the selling price per book for the first edition of 5.000 pcs and 7.5% for the next one from 5 - 10.000 pcs. The mutually agreed advance is to be deposited on your blocked account, immediately upon the signature of the contract.

Should our conditions suit you, we request you to be kind enough and to inform us as soon as possible, together with your counter proposals, if any.

We have made a Selection of your essays according to the taste and interest of our readers, and should we come to reach an agreement, we are ready to send you a list of essays which we intend to include in the said Selection.
