Your letter of September 6th has reached me a few minutes ago. You state that you must postpone your journey to America. I have sent you on the 15th of this month a prepaid passage thru Raterdam from Rotterdam to New York. Since you are not intending to come right away you may send this ticket back to me, so that I can get back the money I paid for it. Should you later decide to come, you can communicate with me and I will send you the required passage ticket.

I note that you have sold the \$40.00 check and have received 83,099 Crowns. I thank you for your trouble in distributing this money as per receipt you enclosed.

On July 22nd, I have sent a large package of clothes to your address. This package of clothes has been delayed in New York, which I just found out two days ago. This package will reach you perhaps in the next thirty days.
