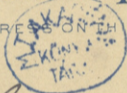

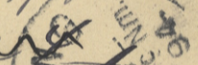

Prof. Dr. Ignatz Goldziher,

My Dear Sir: You are by this time no doubt aware of the terrible visitation which has fallen to our lot in the demise of my dearly beloved father Dr. Kohut 585. He died after a year's severe illness from a tumor of the kidney. He suffered very much indeed, but thank God died in peace like a 70<sup>ish</sup> that he was all his life. He loved you with all the fervor of pure friendship, for between you existed that rare Seelenverwandtschaft which scholarly compatriots feel for each other. He intended dedicating the next part (III) of his "Jemen Studies". He was very much gratified by your kind letter containing corrections to his "Zur Kenntnis" (1891) and had it not been for his severe illness, he would have written to you. May I beg of you my Dear Sir, to publish a Nachruf or a Memorial of his literary activity in the Z. d. P. M. G. or R. E. J., or inscribe to his memory your next volume of the "Muhammedanische Studien". Can you not send me all your magnificent works on Arabic literature?
